If you need help to leave in an emergency:

- At night there will be an ansaphone but don't worry, help is still available
- Contact the police and they will help you to get a safe house
- If you need medical attention go to a Hospital **Casualty Department**

If possible:

- Take your own front door key
- Bring clothing for you
- Please bring proof of income and identity with vou
- Keep our telephone number in a safe place

What's it like living in a safe house?

- This house has a secret location
- The house is clean and well equipped
- You have a key to your own room and the front door
- You cook your own food
 - There will be support for you from a key worker
 - You have your own privacy
- There will be other men in similar circumstances to whom you can talk

How long can I stay?

You can stay for up to 6 months.

During your stay we will provide vou with emotional and practical support.

We will help you with your benefits, your legal options and your housing options.
